Turkish transcript:

Şule: Şimdi bize vermek istediğin son bir mesaj var mı? Belki *exchange* programıyla gelmek isteyen birtakım arkadaşlarımız olabilir.

Seda: Ege Üniversitesi aktif bir üniversite. Yani gelmelerini tavsiye ederim. Gel(e)cekleri zaman pişman olmayacaklar. Olimpiyatlar falan zaten düzenleniyor. Şu an gelip gidiyorlar yabancılar, bir sürü yabancı var. Çevreyi tanıtıyorlar bizim okuldaki öğretmenler, rehberlik yapıyorlar. Herşeyiyle işte tarihini anlatıyorlar, gezdikleri yerlerin. Eğitimi iyi diyorlar. Gelsinler bence görsünler değişiklik olur.

English translation:

Şule: Is there anything else that you want to tell us? There might be some friends who want to come on exchange programs.

Seda: Ege University is an active university. I would advise them to come here. They won't regret coming here when they come. Olympiads are already being organized. Foreigners are currently coming here, there are a lot of foreigners. The teachers at our school are introducing them to the surroundings; they are guiding them. They are explaining the history of the places that they visit. It is said that its education is good. I think they should come and see; it would be a change for them.
