A Boy on His Family

Boy: My hometown is Monipur ... Sylhet, Monipur Tea Estate. My father's name is Mohammad Bachchu Mia, and my mother's name is Jahanara Begum. My eldest brother's name is Anwar.

Interviewer: How many brothers do you have?

Boy: We are six brothers. And I had two sisters. My sisters and my parents have passed away. My brothers are alive. Four of my brothers ... five of my brothers are married. The two of us, the brothers ... I am the youngest.
