

**English translation:**

- What do you sell here?

- Mangoes.

- Only mangoes?

- Fruits.

- Where do you get mangoes from?

- Badamtali. From Badamtali and Rajshahi – both places.

- I see. How long have you been in Dhaka?

- For some time. Seven or eight years.

- How long have you sold mangoes?

- Here? Three months now.
