Job Opportunities

Indonesian transcript:

Maesya: eh ... sekarang Tenike lagi kerja apa?

Tenike: eh ... saya bekerja di bank NISP, sebagai karyawan swasta, yaitu sebagai customer service-nya.

M: dan kapan mulai kerja ini?

T: mulai kerjanya sekitar awal januari kemarin, baru.

M: dan di depan mau jadi apa, mau kerja apa nanti?

T: saya rencananya mau menekuni dunia ini dulu, eh ... untuk jenjang karirnya, mudah-mudahan saya bisa jadi kepala cabang di bank tersebut.

M: eh ... apakah ada banyak aah ... orang muda yang bukan dari Jakarta dari kota lain-lain ah ... datang ke Jakarta untuk cari kerja?

T: eh ... banyak sekali orang muda dari daerah itu ke Jakarta untuk mencari pekerjaan, dan eh .. semua itu dari berbagai latar belakang ya ... dari berbagai latar belakang pendidikan. Dan untuk pekerjaan di sini eh ... tergantung kaya hoki ya ... jodoh-jodohan kalau untuk kerja.

M: jadinya ada lebih oportunita ya ... kerja di Jakarta dari kota lainnya?

T: ya ... ya.

M: Mmm ... apakah kerjaan yang di sini lain dari Surabaya atau Medan kaya gitu-gitu?

T: Kalau saya ... menurut saya sih enggak ya, sama aja semua pekerjaan baik di Jakarta maupun di kota-kota lainnya, hanya mungkin mungkin ya itu kesempatannya. Kalau di Jakarta itu lebih banyak, lebih besar karena kan di Jakarta lebih banyak perusahaan, lebih banyak eh ... kantor-kantor besar ya .. yang membutuhkan karyawan banyak juga.

English translation:

Maesya: Uh ... now, what do you do, Tenike?

Tenike: Uh ... I work in the NISP bank as an employee. I work for customer service (CS).

M: And when did you start working?

T: I started working around early January, not long ago.

M: And what do you want to be in the future? What job do you want to do in the future?

T: I plan to focus on this job first. Uh ... For my career, I hope that I can someday be a branch manager for that bank.

M: Uh ... Are there many young people from places other than Jakarta who come to Jakarta to find a job?

T: Uh ...A lot of young people from other provinces would come to Jakarta to find a job, and uh ... well, they are from a variety of backgrounds, a variety of educational backgrounds. And to get a job here really depends on luck. When it comes to a job, it's a matter of matching up.

M: So, there are more opportunities to work in Jarkarta than in other cities?

T: Yes ... yes.

M: Mmm ... Are the types of jobs here different from that in Surabaya or Medan or any other cities?

T: In my opinion, not really. The jobs available there are the same as in Jakarta or in any other city, only the chances of getting a job differs. In Jakarta, the chances of getting a job are higher as there are more companies, more ... big offices that require more employees.

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
