**After School Activities for Teens**

**Indonesian transcript:**

Pewawancara: Untuk kegiatan setelah selesai sekolah, apakah ada kegiatan ekstra di luar sekolah?

Susan: Ada, jadi eee... yang saya ingat misalnya ada pramuka, lalu ada PMR, Palang Merah Remaja, kemudian ada elektro... ya seperti kegiatan praktek elektronik, elektronika. Kemudian ada juga eee... paduan suara. Kemudian ada juga eee... musik jadi seperti instrument gitu. Para murid bisa memilih mau ikut yang mana tapi itu tidak diwajibkan. Jadi kalau enggak mau ikut juga gak apa-apa. Tapi ada baiknya juga sih mengikuti kegiatan seperti itu, jadi menambah pengetahuan, menambah wawasan..

Pewawancara: kalau untuk organisasi remaja di luar lingkungan sekolah, apakah ada di Indonesia?

Susan: Ada. Jadi seperti di lingkungan eee... di lingkungan sekitar rumah, ada seperti karang taruna, untuk para remaja, para pemuda dimana mereka bisa berorganisasi melakukan kegiatan-kegiatan social. Aa... yang biasanya saya sendiri setuju itu sangat bermanfaat gitu. Da.. daripada mereka melakukan hal-hal yang tidak benar diluar. Kegiatan-kegiatan seperti itu sangat bagus. Juga misalnya kegiatan olahraga, misalnya mereka ngadain volley, atau basket atau sepakbola, itu biasanya hampir selalu ada di lingkungan sekitar rumah.

**English translation:**

Interviewer: What about after-school activities? Do you know of any extra curricular activities?

Susan: Yes there is uh... I remember there were Scouts, and then the Red Cross for teens, and electronics, the electronics club ...well practice to do electronics assemblies. And also there are uh...vocal groups and ...music or playing instruments. So the students can choose the kind of extra-curricular activity they want, but it's not compulsory. It's okay if you don't choose anything. But there are advantages to joining extra-curricular activities, having more knowledge and more experience...

Interviewer: Are there any teen organizations outside of the school environment in Indonesia?

Susan: Yes there are. For example in the neighborhood...uh... around the house, there is a teen's club. They can socialize and do social activities. Uh...I really support that kind of organization because it gives many benefits. Instead of doing bad things outside the

house, the activities in the teen's club are very good. They also have sport activities, for example volleyball, basketball or football... These activities are always available around the neighborhood.
