

Hindi transcript:

चूंकि अंग्रेज सबसे पहले बंगाल में... इन्होंने अपना राज्य स्थापित किया। ईस्ट इंडिया कम्पनी वहां पे पहले ट्रेडिंग के... लिए आई थी, और फिर उसके बाद में कलकत्ता में लॉर्ड प्लासी ने... Fort William establish किया। और वहाँ से अंग्रेजी सियासत सारे हिन्दुस्तान में फैली। तब का education system है कलकत्ते का, और कलकत्ते की universities है, बिल्डिंग्स हैं, वह काफी हद तक अंग्रेजों ने... अंग्रेजों की बनाई हुई है। तब वहाँ का सबसे मशहूर कॉलेज है, वह प्रेसिडेंसी कॉलेज है... कहलाता है। मैं इस कॉलेज से... मैंने medicine पढ़ी, वह मेडिकल कॉलेज है, 1835 में एशिया का सबसे पहला मेडिकल कॉलेज था। और यही कारण है कि वहाँ के लड़के... वहाँ के डॉक्टर्स हैं, वे काफी हद तक अमेरिका या यूरोप नहीं आकर के इंग्लैन्ड आते हैं अपनी higher education के लिए। और वहाँ का education system है, particularly medicine में, वह काफी हद तक ब्रिटिश मेडिकल education की कॉपी है – या उससे काफी inspiration लेता है। इसी कारण से लड़के वहाँ के... वहाँ के लड़के यहाँ आकर के fellowship करते हैं रॉयल कॉलेज के। रॉयल कॉलेज का एक इम्तिहान होता है... और कई लड़के यहाँ पे बस जाते हैं उसके बाद में बंगाली middle class या upper middle class हिन्दुस्तान के अन्य states के मुकाबले में बहुत अधिक anglicized है। ...या फिर यूँ भी कह सकते हैं कि बंगाली are traditionally anglophiles। तब वहाँ की चीजें काफी पसन्द करते हैं। यहाँ का mannerisms, यहाँ के... यहाँ का एक बहुत अच्छी characteristic है, वह है exploration and tourism... यहाँ के अंग्रेजों की। और यह चीजें आपको बहुत बंगालियों में मिलेगी।

English translation:

Since the British first [went to] Bengal ... they established their capital there. At first, the East India Company went there for ... trading purposes, and then Lord Plassey (i.e., Baron Clive of Plassey) established Fort William in Calcutta. From there, the British rule spread to the rest of India. So the education system of Calcutta, and the universities* of Calcutta [and its] buildings were set up by the British ... to a great extent. The college where I ... studied medicine is the medical college which, in 1835, was the first medical college in Asia. And this is the reason why people from there ... the doctors trained there do not go as often to America or Europe for their higher education as they come here to England. And the system of education in Calcutta, in particular, the medical education system is modeled after the British system to a great extent – or at least draws inspiration from it. This is why many people from there ... people from there come here ... and take fellowships at the Royal College. The Royal College ... has an exam ... and many people

settle down here after that. The Bengali middle class or upper middle class is a good deal more anglicized in comparison to [people from] other parts of the country. Or one might say that Bengalis are traditionally anglophiles. So, they tend to like things [about England] quite a bit. The mannerisms of the British, their ... a rather good characteristic feature of the British people – their penchant for exploration and tourism – is something the Bengalis share with them.

(* The speaker probably means ‘university’, since not all universities in Calcutta were set up by the British.)

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
