

Hindi transcript:

- नमस्ते माली भैया।
- नमस्ते जी।
- आप कैसे हैं?
- ठीक-ठाक।
- आज कहाँ से आए हैं?
- अपने घर से ही आया हूँ काम करने के लिए।
- अच्छा, आपके बच्चे-वच्चे ठीक हैं?
- सभी ठीक हैं।
- अच्छा, आज क्या करने वाले हैं आप?
- सफाई-सफूई करे रहे हैं... अभी कर रहे हैं।
- और पानी-वानी भी डालेंगे?
- पानी तो... वैसे आज ही बारिश पड़ी है। पानी डालने की जरूरत ही नहीं है।
- जरूरत नहीं है?
- नहीं है।
- फिर सफाई कर के जाएँगे?
- सफाई कर के जाएँगे थोड़ा-बहुत।
- और ये फूल-वूल जो मरे हुए हैं, इनका क्या करेंगे?
- ये सब...सब सफाई कर रहे हैं।
- और नया बीज डालेंगे?
- नया बीज डालेंगे, पुराने पौधे निकालने के बाद।
- अच्छा, और उसके बाद क्या करेंगे?
- सफाई शुरू कर के, फिर गमले खाली कर के, फूल-पौधे नए तैयार करेंगे लगाने के लिए।
- आज आप ऊपर से नलका लगा के पानी डालिए, ऊपर ताजा पानी का नलका है।
- पानी डालने की जरूरत वैसे भी नहीं है – मौसम ठीकठाक है। बारिश हुई... बारिश हुई पड़ी है।
- वह तो है। ...तो ठीक है, फिर आप सफाई कर के जाइए।
- ठीक है जी।
- कल आ के डालिए पानी।
- कल आ के डाल देंगे जी, डालने लायक होगा, तो।

- अच्छा।

- ये जो मरे हुए पौधे हैं निकाल रहा हूँ। ये गुलदाऊदी हैं। इसको निकालने के बाद फिर दूसरा लगाएँगे।

English translation:

- Namaste, gardener.

- Namaste.

- How are you?

- All right.

- Where have you come from today?

- I have come to work from home.

- I see. Are your children and so on all right?

- They are all doing all right.

- Right; what are you going to do today?

- I am cleaning ... I am cleaning right now.

- And, will you also water [the soil]?

- As for water ... well, in fact, it has rained just today. There is no need to water [the soil].

- There isn't any need?

- There isn't.

- You will leave, then, after cleaning?

- I shall leave after cleaning.

- And these dead flowers and everything – what are you going to do about them?

- All these ... I will clean all of these.

- And will you sow new seeds?

- I shall sow new seeds after the old plants have been pulled out.

- And what will you do after that?

- After starting the cleaning and emptying the pots, I shall prepare [them] for planting new flowers and plants.

- Today you [can] water [the plants] upstairs [with water from a] tap: there is a tap for fresh water upstairs.

- There is no need to water anything anyway – the weather is fine. There has been rain.

- That is right. So, okay, leave when you're done with the cleaning.

- Okay.

- Water [the soil when] you come tomorrow.

- I will [water the soil], if it is necessary to do so [literally “if it is fit [for water]”].

- All right.

- I am pulling out these dead flowers. These are chrysanthemums. I shall plant a new one after pulling this one out.
