

Persian transcript:

محسن: من خودم در سال هزار و سیصد و هفتاد و هشت یعنی حدوداً ده سال پیش وارد دانشگاه تهران شدم. آلبته خب دانشگاه تهران به اصطلاح قدیمترین دانشگاه ایرانه [ایران است] که در سال فکر می کنم هزار و سیصد و نوازده در زمان رضا شاه بنیان گذاری شد. یعنی وزیر فرهنگ رضا شاه که علی اصغر حکمت بود به پیشنهاد دکتر حسابی دانشگاه تهران رو به عنوان روش آموزشی جدید و روشی که متفاوت باشه [باشد] با آموزش سنتی در ایران در تهران بنیان گذاری کردند.

الآن دانشگاه تهران در مرکز دقیقاً در مرکز تهرانه [تهران است]. در منطقه ی امیرآباد. ولی زمانی که این دانشگاه بنیان گذاری شد دانشگاه تهران تقریباً بیرون تهران بود. یعنی اطراف دانشگاه تهران خیلی منطقه ی مسکونی و خیابون [خیابان] نبود. ولی آن چون تهران خیلی بزرگ شده دانشگاه تهران آن به جورایی دیگه دقیقاً در مرکز تهران قرار داره [دارد]. خب دانشگاه تهران آن خیلی بزرگه [بزرگ است] نزدیک بیشتر از سی هزار دانشجو داره. در سال هزار و سیصد و هفتاد و هشت من در دانشگاه در دانشکده ی ادبیات پذیرفته شدم.

English translation:

Mohsen: I entered Tehran University almost ten years ago in 1998. The university is the oldest university in Iran. I think in 1933, in the time of Reza Shah, Ali Asghar Hekmat, the cultural minister at the time, established the university at suggestion of Dr. Hesabi in order to start an innovative and new system of higher education in Iran. Right now, the campus is located exactly in the center of Tehran, in the Amirabad neighborhood. But when the college was built, it was located in the suburbs of the city. Today, however, the city of Tehran has spread out and urban life developed around the campus so that the university is located right in the middle of town. I entered the School of Literature and Humanities at Tehran University in 1998. Well, Tehran University is a large campus with approximately thirty thousand students.

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
