
N: You talked about the entrance exams after high school. Does one's score determine what university he/she can go to or it does not make a difference? Is there a cut-off – say you need 60 or 70 percent to enter a certain university or is it the university that chooses the students?

B: We do not grade with percentages; we grade out of twenty. For instance, ten is the minimum passing grade; if one gets less than ten, he/she cannot pass and twenty is the best. The total grade depends on the individual grades for each subject, which is out of twenty. For instance, if one wants to go to engineering school – they are schools, not colleges – it all depends on the person's grade and they also require an exam. But if the person wants to do law, you easily can because anyone can do law. The same goes for economics, as long as you can handle college. On the contrary, not anyone can do medicine; the student has to do an exam.

N: So, there is a general exam after high school and a specific exam before you enter college?

B: Yes.

N: What are these exams?
