Professor: *Bismi-llāhi ar-rahmāni ar-rahīmi* [Arabic for: In the Name of God, most Gracious, most Merciful]. My name is Dr. Wajid. I am an assistant professor here. Basically, this university started from 1980 and almost more than ten departments in this university are running [means: functional]. I (also) started my earlier education here.
