English translation:

Mid-afternoon Ezan (the third call to prayer of the day,) in Arabic.

They pray in Arabic all throughout the video, except for the point where they declare their intentions of praying from seconds 1:41 to 1:49.

“I declare my intention to perform Sunna of mid-afternoon ritual prayer for the sake of God.”
