

Public vs. Private Secondary Schools

Swahili transcript:

Natasha: Je nani tofauti gani kati ya shule nani, ada tofauti kuhusu shule za private na za sekondari ,I mean et sekodari, za serikali.

Michael: Serikali kidogo wananafuu, kwa sababu kwa mfano shule za private nyingine wanalipa laki mbili na semanini ila serikali wanalipa shilingi elfu arobaini na tano mpaka shilingi elfu sitini. Ndo utoafuti

Natasha: Kwa shule yeyote iliyoko.

Michael: Ya serikali? Aah yani ni apo ni dai, dai ndo hiyo shilingi elfu sitini bodingi ndo sijui shilingi elfu sabini na tano au shiling elfu semanini kwa mwaka mzima. Hata kama kunamichango lakini ni midogo kulinganisha na shule za praiveti. Michango yake ni midogo sana.

Natasha: Aah. Na praiveti gharama yake inaongezeka kulingana na uzuri wa shule na nini

Michael: Egh. Uzuri wa shule vile vile inazidi kuwa na gharama kubwa katika shule za praiveti.

English translation:

Natasha: What's the difference between schools, in terms of tuition...between private and secondary schools...I mean, public secondary schools.

Michael: The public schools are much better, because, for instance, some of the private schools charge about two hundred and eighty thousands but the government charges from about forty five-thousand to sixty thousand shillings. And that's the difference.

Natasha: For any school?

Michael: Of the government? Aah, that's for day schools where you have to pay sixty thousand. For boarding school, I think it's seventy-five or eighty shillings per year. Even when they require contributions, but it's still not as much as private school. The public school contributions are not that much.

Natasha: Aah. And the expenses of private schools increase with the quality of the school?

Michael: Agh. It is true, the better the school, the higher the tuition, especially for private schools.

Natasha: Describe the differences between private school and public school?

Michael: Differences. There are differences.

Natasha: In terms of the available resources or equipment?

Michael: There are differences. They are differences. There are differences because schools like private schools charge a lot because they have large libraries that have all the books you could possibly want.

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
