

Swahili transcript:

Daudi: Mfano kilimo tulichokuwa tunapendelea kukilima, mazao, mazao yapo mahindi, ipo mihogo karanga, viazi. Kwahiyo tulikuwa tuanapata mazao hayo, halafu ukisha imbua kila kitu ikishaleka mjini, unawauzia wananchi. Huuzii serikali. huwauzii watu wa serikali, unawauzia wananchi tu, marahia wema. Ukisha maliza kuuza nini kila kitu, unarejea nyumbani kwenda kupumzika.

English translation:

David: Some of the kinds of crops we used to grow...we raised maize, cassava, groundnuts, potatoes. So we used to raise those crops; then once you have everything ready, you send them to the city to sell to the public. You do not sell crops to the government; you only sell them to the public, the good townspeople. Once you are done with everything, you come back home and rest.

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
