

Explanation:

In Turkmenistan weddings are celebrated in a national, traditional way. Turkmen and European customs are followed. The bride wears two types of dresses. A bride wears the national Turkmen red dress with the national silver dress accessories, and then a European white wedding dress. During the wedding registration the bride wears a white European white dress, and when she is taken out from their parents' house she wears a national dress, which consists of *gupba*,¹ *don*² and *kurte*³ decorated with silver. Weddings are celebrated at restaurants or personal villas. Relatives and friends are invited to the ceremony, which is accompanied by music. The bride's friends help her get dressed.

[At time stamp 4:03 - 4:08]: The special bridal shoes worn in early times as a tradition and decorated with ornaments that represent the tribe. Each tribe has its own ornament decoration.

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- 1 The silver decoration that is on the head of the bride. It's also one of the traditions.
 - 2 National red suit that the bride wear on top of her dress.
 - 3 National robe-like dress; it is used as a cloak, and the bride puts it on her head.
