**SO:** Tunisian *tajeen*...

**SE:** How is the Tunisian *tajeen*?

**SO:** It is made of eggs, cheese and meat of your choice; it can be white meat like chicken, beef or lamb. First, you cook it and then cut it into small pieces and you add eggs and cheese. The choice differs from one housewife to another; each one has her own way. *Tajeen* also differs: there is *tajeen malsouka* and *tajeen* with salad. You prepare the salad by roasting the vegetables like tomatoes, pepper and onions, and then cut it into long pieces. After that, it is mixed with the eggs and cheese and put in the oven; it is a dish that is made in the oven.
