Turkish transcript:

G: Normalde hangi şehirde yaşıyorsun?

E: Normalde Ankara'da yaşıyorum. Benim Ankara'nın en çok sevdiğim semti Küçükesat civarı.

G: Ben de çok severim orayı

E: Çünkü orda oranın güzelliği hem böyle şehrin göbeğine yani en merkezi yere çok yakındır, hem de şehrin böyle daha kıyıda kalmış yerlerine de çok kolay şekilde ulaşırsın, ikisinin tam ortasındadır.

English translation:

G: In which city do you normally live?

E: Normally I live in Ankara. The neighborhood that I like most in Ankara is Benim Küçükesat and its surroundings.

G: I like that place a lot too.

E: (I like it) because that place's beauty (comes from) the fact that you are both very close to the city center, but you can also reach the places that are in the peripheries of the city. You are just in between these two.
