

Turkish transcript:

Bunun dışında Türkiye’de çok güzel kültürel olaylar da yapılıyor, kültürel etkinlikler de yapılıyor. Örneğin büyükşehirlerde özellikle sinemalar ve tiyatrolar çok fazla. Bunun dışında yine klasik müzik konserleri ya da ünlü şarkıların, şarkıcıların, pop şarkıcılarının konserleri her zaman var Türkiye’de.

Other than this, there are nice cultural things in Turkey; cultural events are being carried out.

For example, especially in cities, there are a lot of movie theaters and theaters. You can go to the movies and to the theater whenever you want. There are state theaters, and [there are] also private theaters. Other than this always, usually in cities - there can't yet be in all of them [the cities] unfortunately - you can watch the ballet or the opera.

You can find any type of cultural activity you like. You can go to the art exhibitions, to the museums. Since Turkey is quite rich in history, there are a lot of museums nearly everywhere and in these museums you can see a lot of exhibitions. Other than this there are also classical music concerts or concerts of famous singers and pop singers; they are always present in Turkey.
