Turkish transcript:

Ayşe: Yaz gelince sevindiniz mi yazın gelmesine? Peki neler yiyorsunuz yaz gelince?

Alişan: Armut, elma, kiraz, mandalina, dut...

Ayşe: Mandalina yiyor musunuz yaz gelince? Peki ağaçlardan mı yiyorsunuz, anneniz babanız alıyor da mı yiyorsunuz?

Alişan: Ağaçlardan yemiyoruz, annemiz bize alıyor öyle yiyoruz.

Ayşe: Ağaca çıkıyor musunuz?

Davut: Ağaca çıkmayı biliyorum.

Ayşe: Nasıl biliyorsun?

Mustafa: Ben bilmiyorum.

English translation:

Ayşe: Were you happy with the arrival of summer? So what do you eat when the summer arrives?

Alişan: Pears, apples, cherries, mandarins, mulberry...

Ayşe: Do you eat mandarins in summer? Do you pick them from trees, or do you eat them when your mom and dad buy them?

Alişan: We don't eat them by picking from the trees; our mom buys for us. That's when we eat.

Ayşe: Do you climb trees?

Davut: I know how to climb a tree.

Ayşe: How do you know?

Mustafa: I don't know.
