Uzbek transcript:

Q: Kino haqida nima deb bilasiz, umuman kino bilan qiziqasizmi? O'zbek kinosi haqida...

K: What can you say about the cinema, in fact, are you interested in cinema? About Uzbek cinema...

M: Yes, well, I don't like TV series [soap operas]. But movies...I like movies very much. Well, if the theme is interesting, mostly...I like mostly horror and the movies about travels.

K: I see. What countries' movies of do you like?

M: America...USA.

K · America?

M: Yes.

K: I see. What can you say about Uzbek movies?

M: Aaa...You know, this, 60's, 70's, I like Uzbek movies from 60's, 70's very much, movies of that period. They are very interesting. Even now I watch them with pleasure, but, well, modern Uzbek cinema is not that...is not of good quality that much. Well, I think our Uzbeks are very good to make, at making comedies. But they have not taken up seriously making horror or so called action movies yet.
