

**Uzbek transcript:**

Xo'sh xamirimizni sovutkichdan oldik. Endi qatlamamizni yoyishni boshlaymiz. Manimcha, kessak yaxshiroq bo'ladi. Besh millimetr qalinlikda yoyamiz. Ularni romb shaklida kesamiz...ya'ni besh millimetr qalinlikda...Xo'sh xamirimiz tayyor, endi uni qovurib olamiz.

**English translation:**

Well, we took the dough from the fridge. Now we shall spread *qatlama*. I think it is better to cut it. We shall roll it until it is five millimeters thick. We shall cut them in diamond shape...five millimeters thick... Well, the dough is ready, now we shall fry them.
