Shona transcript:

Hoo, kuchurch, kunoendwa ne Sunday, ehe neSvondo Sunday ndopakunoendewa. Pakati neChina ndoana mai vanoenda kuchina chemamai. Vanonodzidzisanawo eeh, zvekusona, zvimaprojects vachingobatsirana nevamwewo vanenge vasingaziviwo kuti vamwe vari kurarama zvakadiniwo. English translation:

Oh, church, we go on Sundays. Yes on Sundays. Sunday is the day we go there. During the week and on Thursdays women go for their Thursday women's meetings. They teach each other sewing, projects and others get to know what others are doing in their lives. Mothers teach each other the work that they can do with their hands to support their homes. They will be generally helping each other.
