

## Asking Someone Out

### English translation:

If you are about to ask a girl out, according to our culture or the *Zezuru* custom, asking a girl out has certain procedures that you need to take. The first step is to find the girl that you like. When you have found that girl, you need to see if she is worth it for you to ask her out. When you have done that, you then get to a step called the making process. That is the hardest part. This is the time when you want to approach the girl. So what you do is that: some people write letters, others have to go to the girl, others call, but as of me I realized that it was worth it to do all the things [that I mentioned]. I wrote a letter, approached her, and gave her a phone call and went to see her so that it will give a big impression. Right, this is what we call the asking a girl out.
