Kiswahili kinasemwa sana Afrika ya Mashariki. Nchi za Afrika ya Mashariki ni Tanzania, Kenya na Uganda. Nchi ya Tanzania ni Tanganyika ya zamani na visiwa vya Unguja na Pemba. Kiswahili ni lugha ya kwanza ya watu wa Pwani. Waswahili wanakaa Unguja na Pemba, mwambao wa Kenya na mwambao wa Tanganyika. Miji ya mwambao wa Kenya ni Mombasa au Mvita, Malindi, Pate na Lamu. Miji mikuu ya Afrika ya Mashariki ni Nairobi, Mombasa, Dar es salaam, Kampala na Entebbe. Kuna milima michache mirefu. Milima iliyo mirefu sana ni Kilimanjaro, Kenya na Ruwenzori. Hali ya hewa ya Afrika ya Mashariki tofauti katika sehemu mbalimbali. Katika sehemu za juu kama Nairobi na Arusha kuna baridi, na kwenye vilele vya milima kuna theluji. Katika sehemu za chini na karibu ya Pwani kama Mombasa na Dar es salaam jua ni kali, joto na unyevunyevu. Upepo ambao unatoka upande wa baharini unapunguza joto hasa wakati wa usiku. Majira ya hewa ni Kiangazi, yaani Desemba mpaka Machi, siku hizi huwa ni joto sana. Masika huanza mwisho wa Machi mpaka Mei, huu ni wakati wa mvua kubwa sana. Kipupwe, Juni mpaka Octoba, huu ni wakati wa baridi kidogo na ni wakati bora kuizuru Afrika ya Mashariki. Hali ya hewa ni nzuri. Mwezi wa Novemba mpaka Desemba ni siku za vuli, baridi hupungua na joto huanza na mvua hunyesha saa za mchana.
